

Arcadia Publishing Company releases 5th printing of *Along the Brandywine River*

UWCHLAN _ The fifth printing of *Along the Brandywine River*, a postcard history of the Brandywine, has been released by Arcadia Publishing Company, a division of British publisher Tempus Publishing, Inc.

Representatives of Arcadia requested the latest printing earlier this year and copies were made available this week.

“I’m pleased with the continued interest in the book,” Mowday, who lives in Uwchlan, said. “Many residents and visitors to the Brandywine Valley have fond memories of the Brandywine River. The history of the river is told through 212 postcards and a vast majority of them are vintage ones dating before 1915.”

The second printing was ordered seven weeks after *Along the Brandywine River* was released in August 2001. The first printing was completely sold out by Christmas 2001. In all, more than 3,000 copies of the book have been sold.

Mowday has nine books published, including three others by Arcadia. They are pictorial histories *Coatesville* and *Downingtown* and a postcard history of *West Chester*. The *Downingtown* book is sold out, according to Arcadia.

Mowday’s other books are *Six Walking Tours of West Chester*, released last year by Schiffer Publishing of Atglen. White Mane Publishers of Shippensburg, Pennsylvania, has published two of his books, *September 11, 1777: Washington’s Defeat at Brandywine Dooms Philadelphia* and *The Selling of an Author: A Marketing Guide for Writers to Increase Book Sales*. His first book was *Unlikely Allies, Fort Delaware’s Prison Community in the Civil War* by Stackpole Books of Mechanicsburg, Pennsylvania. Squire Cheyney Books of Chester County released *150 Years of Public Service, The Republican Committee of Chester County*.
