

**Author Bruce Mowday signs his book
on Battle of Brandywine on May 11
at Williamsburg Visitors Center**

WILLIAMSBURG, VA. _ Chester County, Pennsylvania, author Bruce E. Mowday will be signing his book on the Revolutionary War Battle of Brandywine on May 11, 2007, at the Williamsburg Visitors' Center.

The book is *September 11, 1777: Washington's Defeat at Brandywine Dooms Philadelphia* and was published by White Mane Publishing of Shippensburg, Pennsylvania. The book took six years to research, write and be published and included research trips to London.

"I'm looking forward to the event in Williamsburg," Mowday said. "Williamsburg embodies the spirit of the American Revolution."

He has written four pictorial history books for Arcadia publishing, *West Chester, Coatesville, Downingtown* and *Along The Brandywine River*.
