Third printing of *Jailing The Johnston Gang*, authorized by publisher Barricade Books

Author Bruce E. Mowday's book has been public for less than a year

FORT LEE, N.J. _ Barricade Books, a leading national publisher of true crime books, this week authorized a third printing of *Jailing The Johnston Gang: Bringing Serial Murderers to Justice*.

“The holiday season was very successful,” said author Bruce E. Mowday. “I did a number of signings, including the Chester County Book Company and local Barnes & Noble stores during December. Several of the bookstores were out of stock by the end of the month and I sold all of the copies I had. The publisher indicated more books will be available this week. I have back orders to fill.”

The book tells story of the dedicated law enforcement officials that placed their own lives in danger to incarcerate brothers Bruce, David and Norman Johnston and their band of paid killers, rapists and thieves.

Mowday is scheduled to give a talk on the Johnston book on Wednesday at the Exton Frazer Rotary at the Great Valley Sheridan. He is also scheduled to be on a WCHE radio program on Friday, January 15. He will also be signing books on January 18 at the Parkesburg Library from 1:00 p.m. until 3:00 p.m. Other talks are scheduled for April 20 at the Oxford Area Historical Society and on May 2 at the Sadsbury Historical Society at 7 p.m. The Oxford location and time have not been set.

Chester County, Pennsylvania, District Attorney Joseph A. Carroll called the leader of the gang, Bruce A. Johnston, Sr., the most notorious criminal in the history of the suburban Philadelphia county. Johnston was convicted of six counts of first-degree murder but Mowday has uncovered information linking Johnston to 10 murders, one of them unsolved, including the ambush slaying of two Kennett Square, Pennsylvania., policemen.
