**Author Bruce E. Mowday is guest
on WVLT-FM 92.1 Chief's Corner radio show
hosted by Robert LaRatta and Vince Borrelli**

*Mowday will discuss this book **Jailing The Johnston Gang** on March 14*

VINELAND, N.J. _ Chester County, Pennsylvania, author Bruce E. Mowday will discuss his latest true crime book on the Chief's Corner show on WVLT-FM, 92.1 on Sunday, March 14.

“Robert LaRatta and Vince Borrelli have a great radio show with a wide audience,” said Mowday. “My book, *Jailing The Johnston Gang: Bringing Serial Murderers to Justice*, fits with the topics covered by the law enforcement hosts.”

The show will air live on Sunday, March 14, 2010, from 11:00 a.m. until 1:00 p.m. WVLT-FM 92.1. The show can also be accessed though the internet by going to the station's website, www.wvlt.com.

LaRatta and Borrelli were members of the Philadelphia police force before LaRatta worked for the federal government in law enforcement and Borrelli entered private security work.

Barricade Books, a leading national publisher of true crime books based in Fort Lee, N.J., authorized a third printing of *Jailing The Johnston Gang: Bringing Serial Murderers to Justice*, in January.

The book tells story of the dedicated law enforcement officials that placed their own lives in danger to incarcerate brothers Bruce, David and Norman Johnston and their band of paid killers, rapists and thieves.

Chester County, Pennsylvania, District Attorney Joseph A. Carroll called the leader of the gang, Bruce A. Johnston, Sr., the most notorious criminal in the history of the suburban Philadelphia county. Johnston was convicted of six counts of first-degree murder but Mowday has uncovered information linking Johnston to 10 murders, one of them unsolved, including the ambush slaying of two Kennett Square, Pennsylvania., policemen.
